## 2018 PROSPECT PARK GARDEN WALK & PLANT SALE

## The annual Prospect Park Garden Walk and Plant Sale will be held on Saturday, June 23, 2018, from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. The Garden Walk is FREE.

This year's Prospect Park neighborhood Garden Walk will be organized around the theme of **Garden Melodies**, featuring gardens inspired by music. There will be live musical performances at some of the sites. The selection of public and private gardens will showcase both well-established and new gardens including pollinator, vegetable, and therapeutic gardens. The 2018 Garden Walk route will focus on the north east part of the neighborhood in the area north of Franklin Ave SE, south of University Ave SE, and centered on Melbourne, Orlin, Clarence, and Seymour Avenues SE.

You can also pick up a map on the day of the walk at the Plant Sale.

**The Plant Sale will be held in the Tower Hill Park**, home of the landmark Witch's Hat Tower. The Park bordered by University, Clarence, Malcolm, Orlin, and Seymour Avenues SE. The sale will offer a range of perennial and annual flowers, foliage, fruit and vegetable plants and shrubs. The sale is a fundraiser for the Prospect Park Garden Club's neighborhood programs, including maintaining the pocket park plantings and buckthorn eradication.

The Prospect Park neighborhood of Minneapolis is located east of the Mississippi River, just west of Hwy 280 along University Avenue, Franklin Avenue, and East River Parkway.
